### I. Welcome and Introductions

- Meeting called to order at 7:02 p.m.
- Board Members Present: Denise Fulton
- Parents Present: 6
- Adoption of the Minutes from the October 7, 2019 Meeting.  
**Action:** Upon motion by Lacy Deringer to adopt the August 26, 2019 Meeting Minutes, seconded by Renee Grecco, the motion carried unanimously.

### II. Principal Report

- The Principal Report was presented by Principal Jackie Smith:
  - o Parent teacher conference feedback has been positive but looking for more parent input. Will send out the survey link again on Wednesday.
  - o Assembly schedule has transitioned to only on Fridays to save instructional time. Tuesdays a student council representative will join Jackie in the office for announcements and to lead the pledge.
  - o Board presentation on November 21st for an LCAP update. Highlights show growth in ELA and Math. Improvement for disadvantaged students but not significant improvement for english learner students. Looking to have consistent data going forward on discipline items such as office referrals and tracking student surveys.

### III. Budget Update

- Marquee is installed and up. Working on programming.
- Electrical in cafeteria and staff room completed and theater curtains are up.
- Starting Arts has started in the classroom with positive student feedback.
- Giving Campaign update: To date \$61,765 received. Money still coming in.
- Boogie Bash: Brought in \$14,717. Ticket price was lowered this year but total revenue only went down \$1,500 from last year.

### IV. Committee Updates

- Giving Campaign: Lacy Derringer
  1. Updated the matrix in handouts. We do accept stock grants and it will be added to communications next year.
  2. There was a 33% family participation which was on track with last year. Of those, 68% donate between \$300 and \$700. Next years targeting message should be toward getting the other 66% of families involved.

3. Could consider asking for more as well next year with an anticipation of around 30% participation.
  4. A few parents asked about breaking up payments which is definitely allowed.

  - Theater Production:
    1. Kids are working hard and progress in coming along
    2. Show will be December 5th and 6th
  - Starlight Auction
    1. Looking for volunteers
    2. Tentative date is late March
  - Project Cornerstone: Laura Brock and Marissa Hoff
    1. Majority of classes have had first lesson.
    2. Building out supplemental books
    3. Potential for expanding to Kindergarten and TK classes. Would need a volunteer to attend monthly meetings and coordinate.

## VI. Announcements

- Pam Foley (Council Member) reached out to HSC Presidents on how she could be helpful. Any issues outside of the school please bring to Denise and she will pass along. One item brought up was the corner of New Jersey and Foxworthy safety. Future improvements in intersection configuration are planned. Currently no budget allocated for an additional crossing guard at that location.
- Parking lot is going to be re-striped and signage added. Asking parents to follow rules for student safety. Disrespect from a minority is hurtful and embarrassing. If the problem continues then the parking lot could be closed. Main issues are people leaving their cars unattended and parents waving their kids to cross between cars to get to the outer passing lane. Denis will email Pam Foley for suggestions and help on traffic patterns/stripping.
- Still very short on volunteers. Monster Boogie Bash had 70% of the needed volunteers. 30% were from Fammatre families, the rest were volunteers from the high school and middle school. Please reach out and volunteer even if for 30 minutes.
- November 8th - Board will serve hot chocolate during lunch to all students
- Book Fair is November 12-15. Still need volunteers, welcome to bring kids. Book fair is also run during lunch. Looking into before-school hours for next year.
- HSC had a request from the music teacher for instruments. A poinsetta drive will be held to raise funds with all profits going to the music program.
- Emergency bags still need to be turned in. Please turn those in as a comfort measure in the event of an emergency as soon as possible. Currently on average only 5 kids per class have a bag.
