I. Welcome and Introductions

 - Gratitude for HSC members and board
 - Highlighting schools and District through new videos online to highlight the great things happening. Hope is to help increase enrollment. Fammatre video is coming out this week.
 - Enrollment decreases are affecting budgets for the District.

 - District is currently fully staffed but retention is a battle.
 - Governor budget comes out in January.
 - New resources for teachers means new learning for curriculum adoptions for core studies and emotional learning.
 - LCAP presentations were done at the last board meeting that discusses the goals for the school. These are important planning tools to find what areas for improvement need focus.
 - Budget advisory committee starts tomorrow. Committee will represent stakeholders and learn educational budgeting basics and provide suggestions on budget refinement. Committee will meet every month and will report in April.
 - CEF is working to get out the word on what they do during the Code Night and how they will start fundraising to support the District in a way that adds to the HSC fundraising.
 - District is working on the school calendar for next year. Input on the parent teacher conferences and the goal setting conferences that were done this year would help to set the calendar.
