TECH UPDATE: STUDENT IPADS, STAFF LAPTOPS

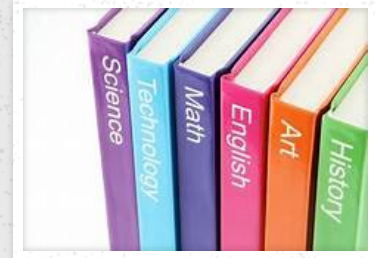
Jackie Smith, Coordinator of Educational Technology, and Mujtaba Rauf, Director of Information Technology, provided an update from the May 17, 2018, Board Meeting, student iPads and shared the survey results for staff laptops. In an effort to ensure equity of access to digital curriculum and online assessments for all students, the District has provided: 6 iPads for each transitional kindergarten (TK) classroom, one iPad for every three students in K-2 classrooms, one iPad for every three students in SDC PK-5 classrooms, and five iPads for every elementary RSP teacher. The District also needs to replace laptops purchased in 2012 to ensure teachers have the proper tools to effectively perform their responsibilities and use for instruction. The Governing Board approved the four year lease agreement total of \$370,050 for staff laptop replacements and

Cambrian District presented its initial 'sunshine statement' to inform the public of matters that will be negotiated between the District and CDTA for the 2018-19 year.
