BOARD OF TRUSTEES VACANCY

Board of Trustees member Aletta Godden stepped down from the Board on Oct. 5, 2018. When a vacancy occurs as defined in Government Code Section 1770, or whenever a resignation of a School Board Member has been filed with the County Superintendent of Schools containing an effective date, the Cambrian School District Board shall, within 60 days of the vacancy or the filing of the deferred resignation with the County Superintendent of Schools, either call an election or make a provisional appointment to fill the vacancy.

APPOINTMENT PROCESS

The Board discussed the process and schedule for filling the one Board member vacancy. The application, process and procedures will be posted by 5:00 p.m. Friday, October 19, 2019. 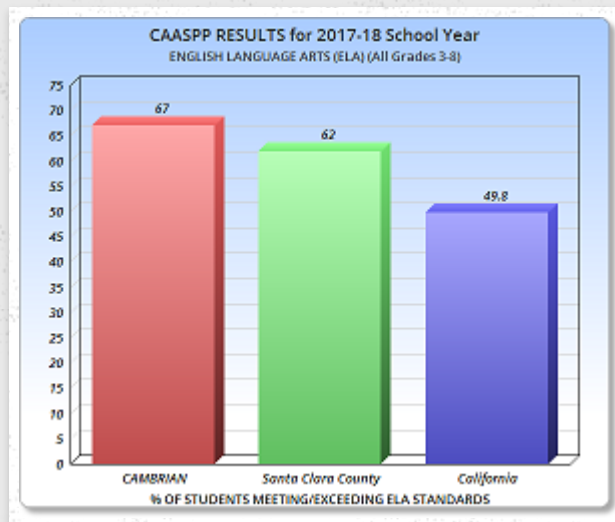
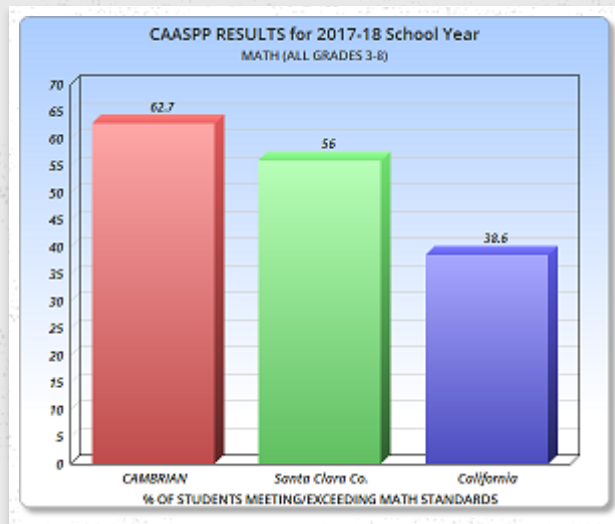

CAASPP TESTING RESULTS UPDATE



Linh Nguyen, Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services, provided an update on Cambrian School District's Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) for 2018-19. The update included an overview of the District's achievement regarding California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) results. This update highlighted Fammatre, Farnham, Bagby and Sartorette Elementary Schools, and Steindorf STEAM and Price Middle School.

CAASPP RESULTS FOR CAMBRIAN SCHOOL DISTRICT



The CAASPP assessment was administered to students in grades 3-8 last Spring for the 2017-18 school year. Cambrian School District students made tremendous growth in both English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics.

KEY FINDINGS AMONG THE RESULTS:

- Cambrian School District students (grades 3-8 in the 2017-18 school year) made significant growth in mathematics with the percentage of students meeting or exceeding standards increasing from 56.3% to 62.7% in one year and a 10% increase over the past two years. This is significant.
- Sixty-seven percent of Cambrian students met/exceeded standards in English Language Arts (ELA) compared to 62% in Santa Clara County and 49.8% in California.

MEASURE I UPDATE

The Board and staff reviewed the Measure I priorities and discussed where to allocate the remaining Measure I funds of \$115,057. The Board reflected on the priority list created in January of 2016, which is based on a \$79 million wish list, and chose to allocate the funds to Sartorette Elementary School for a larger library/flexible learning area.
