

Why Can't I Skip My Twenty Minutes of Reading Tonight?

Student A

Reads 20 minutes five nights a week

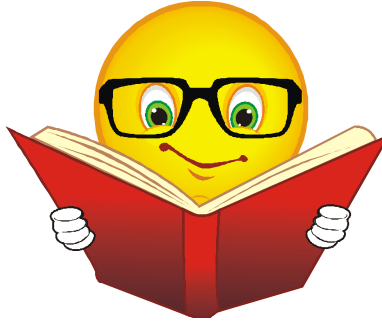
Equals 100 minutes a week

Equals 400 minutes a month

Equals 3,600 minutes a school year

Equals to reading the equivalent of 10 whole school days in 1 year!

By the end of 6th grade this student will have read an equivalent of 60 whole school days!



Student B

Reads 4 minutes five nights a week

Equals 20 minutes a week

Equals 80 minutes a month

Equals 720 minutes a school year

Equals to reading the equivalent of only 2 whole school days in 1 year!

By the end of 6th grade this student will have read an equivalent of 12 whole school days!

One would expect the gap of information retained will have widened considerable and so, undoubtedly, will school performance.
