Review of LCAP:

Goal #1 Promote high academic achievement for all students

ELA – Decreased by 3%

- Adopted Benchmark curriculum in 2019/20 school year
- Should see increase in future scores as Benchmark is a high quality curriculum
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Math – Increased by 4%

- Adopted Eureka curriculum in 2017/18
- Eureka's strong number sense in early grades benefits students in later grades.

Goal #2 Provide highly qualified staff

- 100% teachers are credentialed

Goal #3 PBIS

- Decrease in referrals and suspensions
- Address major behaviors quickly
- Working on aggression on playground
- More work with 5th graders needed

Goal #4 Community Involvement

- School survey participation increased
- Increased parent participation at school meetings
- Meetings can now be viewed online

Next Steps for Bagby:

- Build off professional development and collaboration to implement Benchmark
- Advance Curriculum with fidelity
- Continue professional development around guided reading instructional practices
- Continue implementation of Eureka math curriculum with fidelity
- Leverage TOSAs expertise to examine and improve:
 - o Instructional practices supporting ELs and students with IEPs.
 - o Bagby's Multi-Tiered systems of support
 - o Tier 1 sub group support

- Monitor small sub group of tier 2 students who continue to be pulled out without significant improvement
- MTSS team in place – 2 Gen Ed teachers, Resource Specialist and Psychologist and Principal
 - o Team participating in year-long coaching series o
 - o Team trained on Tier 1 Behavior Supports
