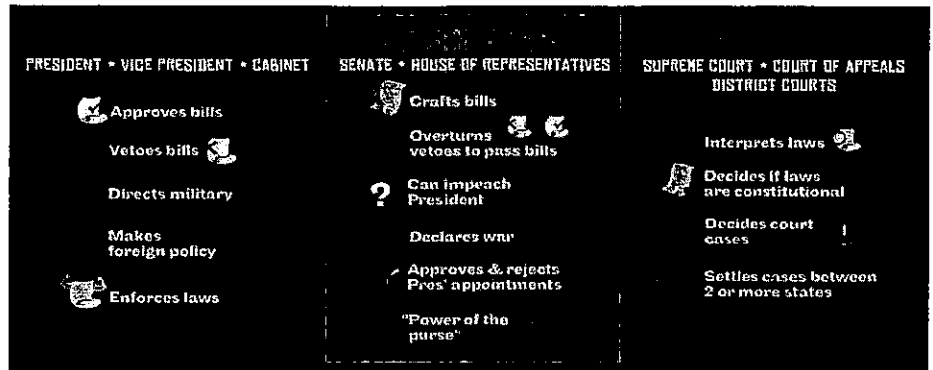
- Identifies each of the three branches of government
