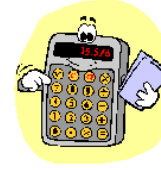




**ASD (Math 7) Course Syllabus
Ms. Sangha Room 18**




Welcome back! I look forward to a semester of exploring math with you. ASD is designed to help you be successful in your regular math class. In this class you will learn CC math 7 standards. Some standards will be pre-taught and other standards will be review of what will be taught in your math class. The eight mathematical practices are an important part of this math class. In this classroom we will understand that “struggle” is an important part of learning, we learn from our errors, and that our neurons make connections when we do challenging work. To ensure success, the list below describes the procedures we will follow in this class.

<p> MATERIALS </p> <p>As a student you will need the following materials in class.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) A folder for on going homework and/or class assignments 2) Binder paper, one notebook 3) Three sharpened pencils (#2) and an eraser 4) One red pen or pencil 5) Metric ruler (15 cm is acceptable) 6) Scientific calculator 7) portable pencil sharpener 8) Four colored pencils, Highlighters (2 colors) 9) Student handbook (will be given to you by the school in the 1st week of school) 10) Glue stick, pocket stapler, scissors

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EXTRA HELP:

If you need extra help, I am available in the mornings and after school. If for some reason you cannot see me at these times, you may make an appointment to see me at lunchtime. There are a lot of new concepts covered in your regular math class so it is important that you seek assistance *as soon as you start having difficulties*.

Your grade in this class will be based on **class work, notebook, materials, tests, homework, quizzes, and participation/attitude.**

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<i>Participation/attitude:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In order to succeed, it is important for students to participate in class. This includes taking notes, answering questions, and following teacher directions. • Worth 25-30 % of final grade
<i>Tests:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tests will cover each chapter or unit. • Each test is worth 10% of the final grade
<i>Notebook:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Notebooks are collected at least once a quarter • Each notebook check is 10% of your final quarter grade
<i>Class work/homework:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your homework and class work will be largely responsible for your success or failure in ASD. Homework will mainly be class work you may need more time to complete. Assignments will be listed on the side white board of the class and posted on PowerSchool. Students will also be given opportunity to write the homework in their handbook. • Classwork is worth 40% and Homework is worth 10%. • Assignments will be due on the assigned day at the beginning of class. Any homework not turned in at this time will be considered late and will receive late credit (50%). Anything turned in later than “1 day late” will receive no credit.
<i>Retest:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any student is welcomed to improve his/her test score by retaking a similar test within a week of receiving the corrected test. For example, if you take the test on Friday, and I return it to you on Monday, you have to correct and retest by the following Monday after school. This policy is put in place to help students learn from their mistakes and improve their grade.
<i>Make Up work:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Since majority of the work is done in class, attendance in ASD class is very important. If you are absent from class for <u>any</u> reason, you are responsible for making up all work. • You are given one week from the day you return to class. Any work that you do not make-up, will be subject to a grade of zero. • Extensions will be given for special circumstances provided the student or parent consults with me about this via note, phone, or in person as soon as the student returns to school. • It is your responsibility to get your missed assignments.
<i>Gold/Silver/Bronze/ Emerald Cards:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • I have confidence that my students will receive one of the listed cards at the end of the quarter. • The homework and or oops passes are good for one day late pass on daily homework assignments. The passes may not be used for long term assignments.
