1. Welcome – meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm. We are live on Facebook so welcome to the people at home too.
2. Approval of [December 3rd, 2019](#) Minutes Raul Silva motioned to approve the December minutes, Shannon Clark seconded. Motion passed.
3. Presidents' Comments - Josh Lyngar
 1. Unfortunately Dr. Andrews will not be able to attend tonight. She will be here for the March meeting.
 2. The April meeting will be 4/14/20, not 4/7/2020

 5. Crab Feed is coming up this weekend. We still have tickets available and are still looking for donations for the silent auction.
4. Principal's Comments - Michael Kretsch
 1. Our City Forest - New Trees
 1. Michael reached out to Our City Forest after the loss of one of our front trees. They have given us a proposal for planting 36 trees on campus with a requested donation of \$80-\$100 per tree. We will cut back on their proposed plan and plan to plant 30 trees. Some of the sites that were suggested are not suitable for the campus; for instance some trees were suggested for the middle of the grass area in the kinder playground. We will need to have a community planting day in order to accomplish the installation of the trees. We are targeting planting as soon as possible since the best time to plant is right now.
 2. Technology Plan Budget Update - Matt Hill
 1. Last year in the spring, we had a 5 year tech plan put in action. Looking to create equity and access across the district. It called for certain ratios of devices. Most elementary schools have a mix of iPads and Chromebook carts and much has been purchased by HSCs.
 2. TK-1st 3 to 1 ratio is the goal. Most of the equipment across the district is at end of life. Bagby has very old iPads. 2nd grade is 3 to 1 Chromebooks. 3-5th grade 2 to 1 Chromebooks
 3. Last week the district approved the funding for replacing the iPads and Chromebooks to meet the tech plan and ratios.

4. Bagby's Chromebooks have end of life June 2020 – 60 units, November 2022 – 30 units, June 2025 – 55

5. [Treasurer's Report](#) - Ian Bruce

1. December 2019/January 2020 We had a couple of board Approved Expenditures
 1. Holiday Gifts for office staff - \$200 expenditure
 2. Will reimburse teachers who went to see the school play for up to \$300.
2. We have \$180,000 in total net assets, of which \$130,000 is unrestricted. We have \$36,000 in board designated savings, and the remaining \$14,000 is split between restricted funds accounts such as Scholarships, Band and Maker's Space.

We are on track with respect to our fundraising for the year, and have currently raised about about \$50,000 more than we have spent. Based on our budget, however, we expect to have a net income/spending of \$0 by the end of the year.
