  1. Motion to approve – Lisa Hilldoerfer, seconded by Ian Bruce, motion passes
3. Presidents' Comments - Lisa Hilldoerfer and Jennifer Vaux
  1. School Spirit Fridays – This kicked off last week with PJ day on Thursday. Every Friday will be Bagby Blue and then we have an additional 4 spirit days on Thursdays.
  2. Bagby Cares – We brought this back again last month. We brought in an additional \$500 this past month and have about \$1000 in this fund to help families in need.
  3. Metzler Land – This was approved at the city council meeting and this is a huge win for the Cambrian School district. This will provide much needed income for the district in the coming years. It is estimated to be \$500,000 unrestricted funds annually for the district.
  4. Return to School – We know that parents have lots of questions. Michael will be hosting a webinar tomorrow at 7 pm to address parents' questions and concerns. The district is also hosting an hour long webinar the hour before.

The HSC board has been organizing some special items for the kids and staff as welcome back. We wanted to increase the excitement and hope to bring some happiness and cheer to everyone.

4. Principal's Comments - Michael Kretsch

Return to school meeting - He will be sending the Zoom link to parents mid day tomorrow and will review the questions so he can address those. We have 82 responses for tomorrow so far. This will be recorded and can be shared out after the meeting.

Some teachers have asked for outdoor space to do some teaching. We are looking for approval for 6 pop up tents to use for the outdoor spaces. They are approximately \$150-\$200 each. We do have a line item in the budget for outdoor space/garden and we can use those funds.

5. Treasurer's Report - Ian Bruce

Total funds: \$186,000  
Unrestricted: \$136,000  
Board designated savings: \$36,000  
Restricted funds: \$14,000

We've only spent about 25% (about \$6,200 out of \$27,000) of our funds designated for teacher stipends. Teachers should note that there is money to spend.

6. Committee Reports

1. STEAM Fair - Kim Tsuchida

1. We extended the deadline for project ideas to Friday 3/5. The sign up is only about 7 projects right now. We are hoping to get a few more projects in. The fair is 4/26/2021 and will be virtual.

2. Art Vista - Cailin Caulfield

- We received lots of positive feedback and thanks for the first Art kit.
- We had our first "virtual art show" (photos of student art) in this week's BNN.
- I will have another slide show every week as long as Mr. Kretsch has time in the BNN.
- Yesterday we delivered approximately 370 new art project kits to Bagby.
- This is the second project for all grades.
- There are YouTube videos with step-by-step instructions for every lesson.

- We are using a mix of videos made by me or videos made by other primary school teachers on YouTube.
- We will organize a third art kit distribution for the first week in April. With one more the first week in May
- I will be able to do a total of four lessons as planned based on my current budget.

Pushed back the submission date for the yearbook to accommodate late school photos. So it should be delivered over the summer.

After the school photographer sends me the pics then the rest of the yearbook can be built around it. With makeup photos scheduled for mid March - I am guessing I will get photos by the end of March.

So for now I am just organizing photos that parents are sending/uploading. Most of the yearbook will be put together in April.

What would be helpful to know- is what events might be happening on campus during these last few months of school? Spirit Days? Decorating Doors for Teacher appreciation week? It would be great to get photos of anything happening on campus in the upcoming weeks.
